2010 JACKSON POP WARNER PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL COACHES AND HELPERS ARE VOLUNTEERING THEIR TIME TO YOUR CHILDREN AND OUR PROGRAM. YOUR COOPERATION, SUPPORT AND RESPECT WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED.

1. Please be prompt. If you are going to be late, try to notify the coach as soon as possible.
2. Stress the importance of attending practices and games.
3. Encourage your child to strive to do their best each day.
4. Work with the coaching staff. If you need to address an issue, please present alternatives.
5. Help us teach good sportsmanship by being positive and avoid talking about the other players or coaches in front of the children.
6. Do not use foul language at any time.
7. Please resolve any coaching conflicts privately. If you feel it cannot be resolved, speak to the coordinator of that program.
8. Cheer for all teams, and avoid displaying your displeasure in a negative way during a game.
9. Do not coach from the sidelines. Your child is part of a team and needs to do as instructed by their coaching staff. You can coach your child at home as much as you like. We would encourage you to become a coach yourself.
10. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY in effect again this season.
11. At any Pop Warner event, practice or competition, any adult who 1) verbally abuses; 2) attempts to intimidate; 3) is fragrantly rude; and/or 4) cannot control their language or actions with an official, coach or Pop Warner volunteer, will be asked to leave the Pop Warner event. He/she will receive a written warning regarding their behavior. His/her child(ren) will be immediately removed from the Pop Warner event.
12. Any adult who commits a second, similar offense will be banned from Pop Warner event(s) for the remainder of the season.
13. Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach or Pop Warner volunteer will be banned from pop Warner, and their child(ren) will be removed from the Pop Warner program for one year from the date of the offense. The child(ren) may not participate in any other Pop Warner Association during the sanction period. After one year, the parent may apply for re-instatement of his/her child(ren). If the adult commits a third offense, he/she will be permanently banned from Pop Warner; and his/her child(ren) will be permanently removed from Pop Warner.

The term "physical assault" includes, but is not limited to, hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking or striking in any way with any body part or any physical implement.

2010 JACKSON POP WARNER PARTICIPANTS' RULES

ATTENDANCE:

Regular attendance is very important to the success of our program. Coaches must be notified, in advance, if your child will be absent from practice or a game. Parents must provide transportation to and from practices and games. When dropping off your child, please be sure that coaches have arrived. In the event of an injury, coaches will need to contact a parent/guardian for the participant. Please make sure your contact information is updated on your child(ren)'s participant card. A parent, or someone designated by the parent, must pick up each child. If another adult will be picking up your child, the coach must be notified of the change in writing. Please be prompt when dropping off and picking up your child. No child will be allowed to leave without a parent, and no child may walk home.

PRACTICE:

Practice will be held at the Jackson Pop Warner complex (next to the Lucy Holman School) through the month of August, ten hours per week. Days and times will be determined by the coordinators and/or coaches. Once school begins, practice will be six hours a week. The coaches will inform you of the nights of the week that practices will be held. In the event of inclement weather, parents should come for their child(ren) immediately, football/cheerleading practice cannot continue if there is thunder and lightning.

GAMES:

The games are held on Saturday and Sunday, however there may be a few games played during the week. Many towns, including Jackson, have lights on their fields. Therefore, some games will be played at night. Game schedules will be provided as soon as they become available. Our regular season ends around the end of October. Our competition level teams (Jr. Pee Wee, Pee Wee, Jr. Midget and Midget) may participate in post-season play. This year we have chosen to participate in the Regional Playoffs, which can qualify for the National Championships in Disney. In this case, the season could last into mid-December. All participants are expected to attend every game, and stay for the entire game. All dates and days are subject to change.

APPEARANCE:

All participants are expected to be neat and clean for practices and games. Hair is to be worn neatly, off the face. Girls are NOT permitted to wear nail polish, artificial nails or excessive makeup. Football players AND cheerleaders are NOT permitted to wear bandanas. All participants are NOT to wear jewelry of any kind (no rings, watches, body piercings, necklaces or earrings). Medical bracelets or necklaces are permitted; however, they must be taped to the wrist or chest area. You will be given a list of items needed to be purchased by you to complete your uniform. Uniforms are to be worn for games and official Pop Warner approved functions. All game uniforms and equipment are to be returned on the scheduled date at the completion of the season. Upon receipt of game uniforms and game equipment, you will receive an invitation to our annual awards banquet.

CONDUCT:

Disrespect, disobedience, fighting or using foul language will not be tolerated and will result in disciplinary action. All participants are expected to follow instructions and respect their coaches and other team members.

2010 JACKSON POP WARNER STRIKE SYSTEM

A STRIKE SYSTEM IS USED TO MONITOR THE RULES THAT YOU HAVE AGREED TO ABIDE BY. ACCUMULATION OF 15 POINTS WILL RESULT IN A HEARING BETWEEN THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND THE PARENT OF THE CHILD. CONTINUED STRIKE ACCUMULATION, AFTER 15 POINTS, COULD RESULT IN THE REMOVAL FROM OUR PROGRAM.

2010 JACKSON POP WARNER COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL COACHES, FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING, WILL ABIDE BY A CODE OF CONDUCT WHICH INCLUDES THE PROVISIONS WHICH FOLLOW. IF ANY OF THESE RULES ARE BROKEN, THE HLA (HIGHEST LOCAL AUTHORITY) SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE A PENALTY. COACHES SHALL:

1. Not smoke and/or use smokeless tobacco on the field.
2. Not criticize players/participants in front of spectators, but reserve constructive criticism for later, in private, or in the presence of team/squad members if others might benefit.
3. Accept decisions of the game officials and judges, both on the field and in competitions, as being fair and called to the best of said officials.
4. Not criticize an opposing team, its players, coaches, cheerleaders, or fans by word of mouth or by gesture.
5. Emphasize that good athletes strive to be good students, and that both are physically and mentally alert.
6. Strive to make every football/cheerleading activity serve as a training ground for life, and basis for good mental and physical health.
7. Emphasize that winning is the result of good homework.
8. Not engage in excessive sideline coaching, and shall not leave the bench area to shout instructions from the sidelines.
9. Together with team officials, be jointly responsible for the conduct and control of team fans and spectators. Any fan who becomes a nuisance, and out of control will be asked to leave.
10. Not "pile it on", or encourage their team to get a commanding lead and raise the score as high as it can. In these instances, every effort shall be made to let all players play.
11. Not use abusive or profane language at any time
12. Not receive any payment, in cash or kind, for services as a coach in Pop Warner Football/Cheerleading.
13. Not permit or encourage "sweating down" tactics in order for a player to make team weight.
14. Not permit an ineligible player to participate in a game.
15. Not deliberately incite poor sportsmanlike conduct.
16. Abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance on both the game and practice fields.
17. Remove, from a game or practice, any participant when even slightly in doubt about his/her health, whether or not as result of injury, until competent medical advice is available.
18. Control their fans. Remember, as a team coach, you are responsible for your team, and fan reaction will usually be in step with your reactions.
19. Uphold all rules and regulations, National and Local, regarding Pop Warner Football and/or Cheer.

I further understand that all uniforms and equipment are the sole property of Jackson Pop Warner and will be returned upon the end of the season or the withdrawal of my child. All equipment and uniforms must be returned prior to our annual Banquet or participant will not be allowed to attend the Banquet.

As the parent or legal guardian of the above child, I hereby give full consent and approval for my child to participate as a team member in Jackson Pop Warner for the 2010 season. I understand that there are certain risks of injury in the practicing and playing of the sport, as well as traveling, if and when required, and other related activities incidental to my child's participation. I am willing to accept these risks/requirements on behalf of my child. 1. PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE

2. INTENT TO INFORM

I acknowledge that I am fully aware of the potential dangers of participation in any sport and I fully understand that participation in football, cheerleading and/or dance may result in **SERIOUS INJURIES, PARALYSIS, PERMANENT DISABILITY AND/OR DEATH**. Furthermore, I fully acknowledge and understand that protective equipment does not prevent all participant injuries, and therefore I do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the local, league and regional Pop Warner organization(s), Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc., and any and all organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting the above named participant to and from activities, from any claim arising out of any injury to my/our child whether the result of negligence or for any other cause.

3. EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

I hereby grant my permission for any and all emergency medical/dental treatment and/or first aid to be administered to my child/participant, including authorizing any medical treatment facility/hospital to administer emergency treatment, for any illness/injury/accident resulting from participation in any and all Pop Warner activities.

4. EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY

I agree to assume full responsibility for any and all equipment/uniforms loaned to the above named participant and I agree to promptly return, upon request, the uniform and other equipment issued to the above named participant in as good condition as when received except for normal wear and tear. If I fail to adhere to this policy, I will be responsible for the replacement cost of such equipment. I agree to furnish an authentic certified copy of a birth certificate of the above-named participant to local Pop Warner officials.

5. INSURANCE DISCLOSURE

I am aware that my local Pop Warner organization carries group accident insurance which is considered secondary or excess for medical purposes to any and all valid insurance I possess is considered primary insurance. Furthermore, I agree to notify in writing my head coach and local Pop Warner organization of any medical claim as a result of participation in Pop Warner as soon as reasonably possible. I understand that any registration fee paid does not constitute a direct premium for insurance and that a deductible(s) may apply.

6. SCHOLASTIC VERIFICATION

I hereby stipulate that either my child is scholastically fit, or that I have completed the scholastic eligibility form or the Home School Eligibility Form and will adhere to all rules and regulations therein. Furthermore, I hereby authorize my child's school to release school grades, report card results, and any and all other pertinent scholastic information to the local Pop Warner organization in order to comply with Pop Warner's scholastic fitness requirements.

7. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

I hereby stipulate that I have been advised by the local Pop Warner Organization of my rights, if any, to a refund in accordance with the local organization policies, and I have also been advised of my fundraising obligations for the entire season and agree to fully comply with those obligations.

8. COMMUNICATION AND PROMOTIONAL CONSENT

As a condition to my child's participation, I hereby consent to receive communications via email and mail from Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc. and its partners. I understand that Pop Warner Little Scholars does not sell its contact lists and communications sent may contain program information as well as special offers and may be opted out of by following the instructions in the email or via written request to the Pop Warner National Office. Furthermore, I hereby grant to Pop Warner the absolute right and permission to make, reproduce, broadcast or otherwise use participant's name and likeness, any photograph, films, videos, recordings, or other depictions or images in whatever form or media in connection with participation in Pop Warner throughout the universe in perpetuity and in any and all advertising and promotion materials, in any manner or media whatsoever for purposes of art, advertising, editorial, trade or promotion or any other purpose whatsoever. To the extent that any benefit accrues or may accrue to Pop Warner, I hereby and forever waive any interest in or claim to such benefits and acknowledge that Pop Warner is under no obligation to exercise any rights granted herein.

9. ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT:

S1: In order to uphold the goals of Pop Warner and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of Pop Warner events, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times.

S2: Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a Pop Warner event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, must receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave a Pop Warner event. The member organization may also provide a written warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior. The adult's children may also be removed from the event. Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for a period of one year from the date of the second offense, and their children may also be removed from the program(s) for that time period.

S3: Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all Pop Warner programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all Pop Warner events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all Pop Warner programs.

10. ADHERENCE TO POP WARNER RULES AND PROCEDURES

I hereby understand and acknowledge that as a parent/guardian of a Pop Warner participant it is my responsibility to comply with all rules and regulations stipulated, adopted or recognized by Pop Warner Little Scholars Inc. or any of its member organizations and understand that any non-compliance with any and all rules and regulations may be cause for discipline and/or dismissal of the participant, myself, and/or any spectators or other persons affiliated with the undersigned and the above named participant. I further understand that the participant must meet Pop Warner age and/or weight requirements on their official certification date as established by Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc. without exception and that the decision of the Weigh Master is final.
